PROGRAM PARTICIPANT BILL OF RIGHTS

Each person has the right to be treated respectfully.

Each person has the right to expect confidential information in their case file to be confidential.

Each person has the right to make a mistake and learn from it.

Each person has the right to make choices.

Each person has the right to accept the consequences of the choices they make.

Each person has the right to be free from physical, verbal, emotional, and mental abuse.

Each person has the right to ask for help including, but not limited to, legal assistance.

Each person has the right to participate or refuse participation in research activities.

Each person has the right to know what to expect from Goodwill of the Great Plains and its staff.

Each person has the right to know what is expected from them.

Each person has the right to expect to work in a safe environment.

Each person has the right to expect freedom from retaliation and humiliation.

If research using human subjects or personal information is conducted at Goodwill of the Great Plains, current acceptable research guidelines will be followed.

Each person has the right to be free from financial exploitation and neglect.

Each person has the right to access their case record at any time by providing written notice to their assigned Mission Services representative.
